

Help the Swedish Police stop child sexual abuse



The Swedish Police take all types of sexual offences against children very seriously, regardless of where in the world these crimes are committed.

Sexual offences, other than rape, may consist of touching children in a sexual way, filming or taking photos of children and forcing or making children perform various types of sexual acts. This also applies to sexual offences committed through the Internet.

According to Swedish legislation, Swedish nationals may be subject of investigation and convicted in Sweden for sexual offences committed against children under the age of 18 in other countries. For this reason, the Swedish Police have a special unit assigned to investigate these crimes. This unit has, on several occasions, travelled abroad to conduct criminal investigations which have resulted in convictions and prison sentences.

You can help us stop the perpetrators!

Mail your information to the Swedish Police! It's easier to take legal action if the information is detailed and comprehensive. This information may consist of the following:

- What happened?
- When?
- Where?
- Against whom?
- Witnesses?
- Perpetrators?

Names, nationality, physical description, etc. If the perpetrator is not a Swedish national, please report this to the relevant country. If not, please inform the Swedish Police about it and we will forward the information.

- Photos, films, voice recordings, notes, records, chat, logs or other documentation.
- Contact details of the information provider, the victim and other involved individuals.
